The dimensions of the framed picture are: 30" long x 26" high. The frame is Barn siding with a double acid-free mat board. The medium is Gouache on Strathmore 400 Bristol.

Proceeds from the raffle are for a multi-use pavilion providing a location for educational programs, a meeting area for family reunions and other groups, and a small storage area for the Park District. The Nature Center is Preble County's first county park and is located at 9691 SR-503 N, Lewisburg. It opened to the public in April of 2008 and offers 33 acres of nature trails, a 400' handicapped accessible boardwalk at the forest trail head, and a small wetland.
